Titus 1:1-15

¹Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness; ²In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began; ³But hath in due times manifested his word through preaching, which is committed unto me according to the commandment of God our Saviour;

⁴To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour. ⁵For this cause left I thee in Crete, that thou shouldest set in order the things that are wanting, and ordain elders in every city, as I had appointed thee:

⁶If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly. ⁷For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre; ⁸But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate; ⁹Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.

¹⁰For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision: ¹¹Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake. ¹²One of themselves, even a prophet of their own, said, the Cretians are alway liars, evil beasts, slow bellies.

¹³This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith; ¹⁴Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the truth.

¹⁵Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled.

⁹Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.

PASTOR'S COMMENTARY CONT'D

"Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; 9 And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me. 10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve."

"SHOW ME"

I am often asked by people to show them in the bible where there is a specific verse that says to do or not to do a things. I understand . However, this is really TELLING also. Because it can actually demonstrates that such a person has not properly or thoroughly understood union with Christ. Sure there are specific verses about what we should and should not do. But often they are principles rooted in the gospel of His glory! 1 Cor 10:31

That is not how a grounded Christians should think. "Does this Honor Christ? Does this advance His glory? I am His and He is mine. I live for His honor!

If you do your research you will find that the history of Halloween, is rooted in Catholic syncretism, pagan harvest festivals, and ultimately Wicca, witches, and demonic celebration that the world is glad to worship the dead. Dead things. Idols, images, icons etc.

"What about an alternative festival?"

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your

good works, and glorify your

Father which is in heaven.
Matthew 5:16

Many Christian Churches do that. But let's be frank. There are Christian night clubs and Christians bars. There are all sorts of Christian fillers. This too is telling!

How about PRAYER that night. This is really a warfare. Eph 6:12-19

The costumes that the children are wearing actually become
their lifestyles before long. Bible reading, listening to a

good message before bed. Talk to the children about the blessings of God. Fix a pie, some home made goodies and let them know that God is Great, Good, and Ready to save lost people like them who wish to "put on a mask instead of Christ".

The very fact that Christians struggle with this makes it a temptation for sure.

⁹When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ¹⁰ There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his

daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, ¹¹ Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.

Deut 18:9-11

Does it glorify God? Does it honor Christ? Does it advance the truth?

²⁰But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils. ²¹Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils. ²² Do we provoke the Lord to jealousy? are we stronger than he? 1 Cor 10:20-22

Are you promoting light or darkness? Is the atmosphere and event an accurate reflection of the true nature of things? Or is it promoting a lie?

The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.

Rom 13:12

What is the virtue of abstaining from such pagan holidays?

A love for Christ. A devotion to Christ. And a contentment with Christ. THIS IS THE REAL ISSUE!!!!! "But Sanctify the Lord in your heart and be ready" 1 Pet 3:15

I think that many professing believers do not find that level of devotion and contentment to Christ that allows them to readily see the devil and his seductive allurements seeking to provoke them to honor him and dishonor Christ.
