Galatians 1:1-16

¹Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;) ²And all the brethren which are with me, unto the churches of Galatia: ³Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ, ⁴Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father: ⁵To whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

⁶I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: ⁷Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. ⁸But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

⁹As we said before, so say I now again, if any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed. ¹⁰For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

¹¹But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. ¹²For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ. ¹³For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it: ¹⁴And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers.

¹⁵But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by his grace, ¹⁶To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood:

Question? How does one get saved? Thanks so much for your help.

Answer. *For by Grace are Ye saved, through Faith, and that not of yourselves, it is a gift of God not of works;* Eph 2:8,9

God does the saving. Titus 2:5. No where does it say get saved. It says be saved. That is BELIEVE on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved.

The evangelical Church has made salvation a decision for Jesus. But no where in the bible does it say to decide for Jesus. It says to believe. This is a decidedly more involved and thoughtful process.

Because a decision is a one time act from which people walk away thinking that they have made the requirements for salvation. Rom 8:9,10. The gospel does not promote this message. The epistles do not demonstrate this process. They both call for understanding the claims of Christ and following him in obedience. That is saving faith. John 8:30,31

But believing is the work of God, wrought in a persons heart by the Spirit of God. John 6:29

So that we encourage people to believe, not make a decision. That will cause them to think about what to believe, which will require an education. John 6:45. And is the mean by which faith is planted. Rom 10:17

They will know for sure that they believe because they will agree with what the bible says about Jesus, as they hear him explained and taught. But you cannot believe someone you do not know. Mt11:28

The gospel must be preached and people are called to believe on him. But the response of faith is from God. 1cor 1:18.21
