

The antidote to all forms of covetousness?


An experiential knowledge of Christ as YOUR SHEPHERD! He is good to His sheep. They have need of nothing who lay hold of Him for eternal life.

PRIDE

Pride is a groundless thing. We have reasons for almost everything, but we have no reason to be proud. Pride should be unnatural to us, for we have nothing to be proud of. Our creation ought to humble us, for we are frail creatures who are here today and gone tomorrow. Our ignorance should be sufficient to lay us low. We spend a lifetime trying to learn a few things in part; then in old age, we can’t remember where we left our glasses. Our sins should lay us in the dust, for it would be embarrassing for the most trusted friend to view our hearts. Our blessings ought to humble us; for the more we have, the more we are in debt to God who makes us to differ. A great debtor has no cause for pride. Certainly a believer has no cause for pride, for our salvation is all of grace! Mephibosheth accurately summed up our confession, “What is thy servant, that thou shouldst look upon such a dead dog as I am?” Let us pray to be delivered from pride, for it is such a subtle enemy that only the Lord can deliver us; but we must be delivered, for “God resisteth the proud and giveth grace to the humble.”

(1) The Pattern of Christ in Paul a comfort of the saints: vs. 7, 9 signified in the apostle. A great model. Follow me, as I follow Christ. 1Cor 11:1/ 1Tim1:16 1Thess 1:6/ 2:14/ 3:7 / Col 2:5/ 1Cor 4:14-17, 21

This is a sin which the world does not rebuke; the most faithful minister can scarce smite its forehead. God knoweth what thunders I have launched out against men who are all for this world, and yet pretend to be Christ's followers; but yet they always say, “It is not for me.”

God has said he will never leave us, and if we have him we possess all things. Who has need to be covetous when all things are his, and God is his?
